- What are you doing? = ¿Qué estás haciendo? → I'm studying English at the moment.
- What is he doing? = ¿Qué está haciendo? → He's downloading a new app.
- What are they doing? = ¿Qué están haciendo? → They are setting up a network.

También podemos formular preguntas más específicas como:

- What is he checking?
- What are you writing?

Recordemos que además podemos preguntar con las demás WH words, (who, when, where, why, etc. cuando el contexto lo permite)
