WH words or question words:

Who asking about a person = ¿quién?

What asking about a thing or an idea = ¿qué / cuál?

When asking about a time = ¿cuándo?

Where asking about a place = ¿dónde?

Why asking about a reason = ¿por qué?

How asking about the way you feel or the way you do something = ¿cómo? Estas preguntas solicitan un tipo de información específica: ¿quién? ¿dónde? ¿cuándo?, etc., y requieren como respuesta una oración completa, (S + V +información).

 Las Yes-No solicitan confirmación de algo, por lo tanto tienen un tipo de respuesta especial que se llama short answer y que básicamente responde con sí o no a lo que se preguntó (Yes, + S + BE / No, + S + BE + not)
