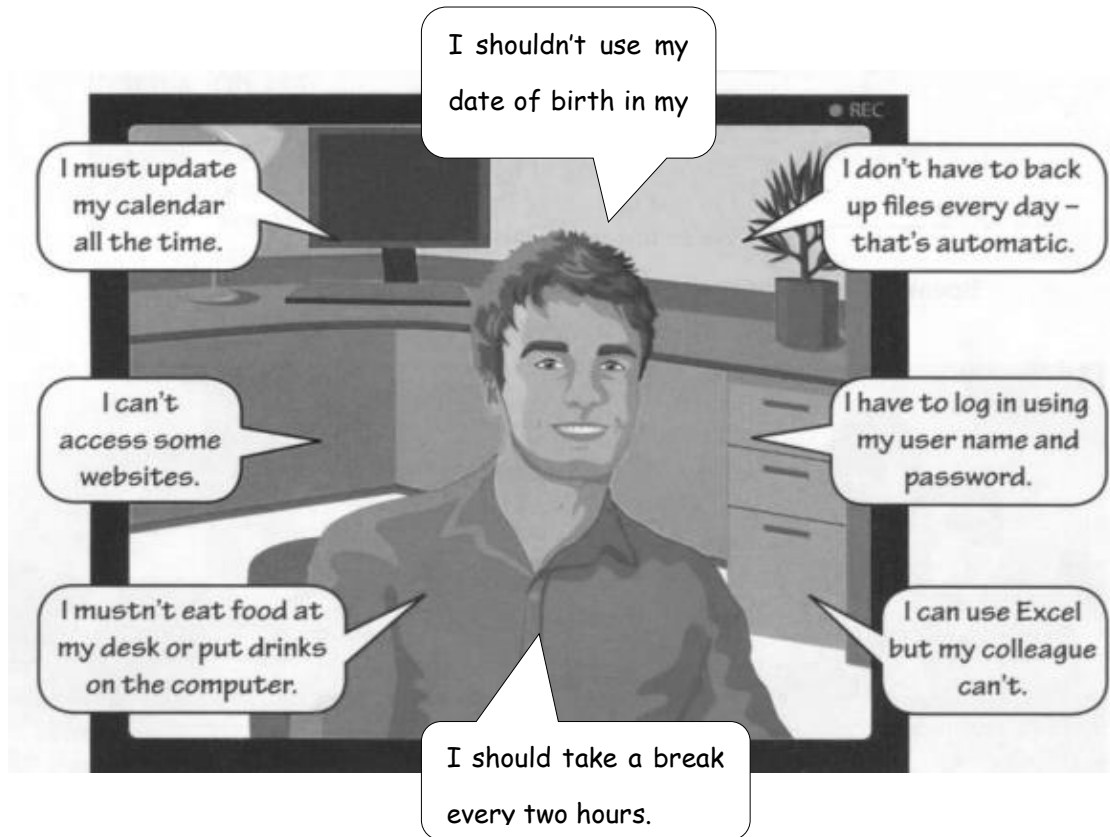


Modal Verbs Exercise 2

- f. I **can't** access some websites. → It is an obligation / It is a prohibition.
- g. I **should** take a break every two hours. → It is an ability / It is a good idea.
- h. I **shouldn't** use my **date of birth in my password**. → It is necessary / It is not a good idea.
