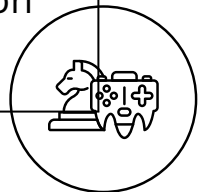
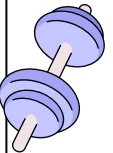




# The simple present

FORM	STRUCTURE	RULES	EXAMPLES
AFFIRMATIVE	Sujeto + Verbo (en su forma base)  S + V + "s" (solo con he/she/it)	En la forma afirmativa, usamos el verbo en su forma base. Para <b>he/she/it</b> , añadimos <b>-s</b> al final del verbo.	- I <b>have</b> breakfast at 7:00. - She <b>works</b> in an office.
NEGATIVE	S + do/does + not + Verbo (en su forma base)	Usamos do not (don't) o does not (doesn't) + el verbo en su forma base. Usamos <b>doesn't</b> solo con he/she/it.	- I <b>don't speak</b> Italian. - He <b>doesn't go</b> to the gym on Sundays.
QUESTIONS	Do/Does + Sujeto + Verbo (en su forma base) + ?	Para hacer preguntas, usamos do o does antes del sujeto. <b>Con he/she/it, usamos does.</b>	- <b>Do</b> you <b>play</b> strategy games? - <b>Does</b> she <b>work</b> on weekends?
