


MAKING QUESTIONS

1) Present Simple with Verb BE (am / is / are)

- ☒ Yes/No Questions (Verb *BE* comes before the subject)

Structure	Example	Short Answers
Am/Is/Are + Subject + Complement?	Is he a software developer ?	Yes, he is . / No, he isn't .
	Are they in the office today?	Yes, they are . / No, they aren't .
	Is she a game artist ?	Yes, she is . / No, she isn't .

They are in the office today


Are they in the office today?

- ☒ Wh- Questions (Question word + *BE* + subject)

Structure	Example
Wh- + am/is/are + Subject + Complement?	Where are you from ?
	What is his job ?
	Where is the team now?

The team is in the office.


Where **is** **the team**?

Remember!

Where = dónde

When = cuándo

What = qué

Why = por qué

What time = a qué hora

How = cómo

2) Present Simple with Other Verbs (do/does)

☒ Yes/No Questions (Use do/does + base verb)

Structure	Example	Short Answers
Do/Does + Subject + Base Verb + Complement?	Do you write code every day?	Yes, I do . / No, I don't .
	Does she design 3D models ?	Yes, she does . / No, she doesn't .
	Do they develop software for mobiles?	Yes, they do . / No, they don't .

She **designs** 3D models.

Does **she** **design** 3D models?

💡 **Remember!:** With **he/she/it**, use **does** and the **base verb** (no -s in questions).

Example: Does he **work** remotely? ☒ (Not: Does he **works**...)

☒ Wh- Questions (Question word + do/does + subject + base verb)

Structure	Example
Wh- + do/does + Subject + Base Verb + Complement?	What does he do ?
	Where do they test the game ?
	When does she check her mail ?
	Why do programmers use Git ?

She **checks** her mail in the morning.

When **does** **she** **check** her mail?

Examples (All Together)

With *BE*:

- Is he a **backend developer**? — Yes, he is.
- Where is the **design team**? — They're in **Room 12**.

With other verbs:

- **Does she write code in Python?** — Yes, she does.
- **What do they develop?** — They develop **mobile apps**.
- **Do you test software before release?** — Yes, we do.

Mini Practice (optional for your students)

1. **Yes/No questions** (write questions):
 - (be) She / a project manager → **Is she a project manager?**
 - (other verbs) They / test games → **Do they test games?**
 - (other verbs) He / design 3D models → **Does he design 3D models?**
2. **Wh- questions** (write a question for the answer):
 - Answer: "I write code in C++." → **What language do you write code in?**
 - Answer: "They are in the IT lab." → **Where are they?**
 - Answer: "She develops VR software." → **What does she develop?**
